It is reported that Sri ARABINDA BASU (E.S.P.), DHIRENDRA BHOLMIK (E.C.), RAMEN DE of Harrison Road, formerly of I.S.W.A., SIBABRATA RAY of SARAT GHOSH STREET and AJIT BASU (E.S.P.) have since separated from Sri DWARAKESH MITRA'S group (A.B.S.C.) and started a new party office on the 3rd floor of premises No. 16/17 College Street. BASU'S group is going to be helped by Sri GOPAL MUKHARJI and his followers, in case of any clash with MITRA'S group. According to party circles, BASU recently procured one Pistol and two revolvers with few ammunition from an I.N.A. dump, situated in Asansole area, through the introduction of Ex-I.N.A. Captain RAM SINGH. This lot has now come into the hands of Sri GOPAL MUKHARJI. It transpired from a recent talk with Sri AJIT BISWAS that besides the I.N.A. lot, GOPAL MUKHARJI has also secured one Military hand-grenade through BASU'S source. MUKHARJI is now contemplating to attempt on the life of Sri S.N. CHAKRABARTI, Commissioner of Police, while the latter will attend a Puja-pandal opening function in North Calcutta as a chief guest by throwing military hand-grenade. It is said that MUKHARJI recently dep one of his gang member (incompletely identified) (aged about 24/25 years, fair complexioned) residing at 41 Malanga Lane to watch the movements of the Commissioner of Police, near his Kyd Street residence. Out of the I.N.A. lot of arms and ammunitions, one Iver Johnsons Arms and Cycle Works U.S.A. made 5 chambered revolver bearing number T.D.-A.P.R. 6-86 FEB. 15. 87 with 5(.38) Y 10.87 MAR. 13. 88 AUG. etc. cartridges has since been procured through a contact and are produced for inspection.
